

Registration Steps

All current students who plan to continue for Fall Semester 2024 should register for classes before leaving campus at the end of Spring Semester.

Undergraduate and Graduate Students

- Confirm your registration date and time through myCU/Student Planning.
- Create your schedule plan in myCU/Student Planning.
- Meet with your advisor to discuss your schedule.
- Activate your schedule in myCU/Student Planning.
- Verify that your schedule is accurate through your myCU/Student Planning account.

All students, including freshmen, should work with their advisors to develop their class schedules for Fall Semester. Currently enrolled freshmen will not receive pre-generated schedules for this registration cycle.

Course Information for Fall Semester 2024 is available through myCU. Search on View Undergraduate Course Schedules.

Registration Guidelines

Financial Terms and Conditions

All students must complete the financial terms and conditions agreement process in their myCU account before they are eligible to register for Fall Semester 2024. In myCU, search for "Sign Financial Terms and Conditions".

Online Courses

Requests for online courses from traditional undergraduate students are considered based on availability and need. To request an online course:

- Login to myCU and search for "Request Online Course" **OR**
- Open the "Course Schedules" webpage and click the link to Fall 2024 Registration for Online Courses.
- Complete and submit the electronic form to initiate the request process.

You must come to the Office of the Registrar in SSC-132 to obtain a form to register for:

- Classes that are filled
- Classes with overlapping meeting times
- Classes that require instructor approval
- Course schedule overloads
- Non-traditional courses (Independent Study; Internship)

Financial Information

You may view your student account balance and current invoice through myCU. Search “View Student Account”.

Your first payment is due on August 5, 2024. Accounts paid after this time are considered late and are subject to a \$25 late payment penalty.

Payment Methods:

- Check: Make your check payable to Cedarville University. Please write your ID# on your check.
- Pay online: Go to myCU.cedarville.edu. Search for “View Student Account/Pay Bill”.
- Credit Card: Visa, Mater Card & Discover are accepted with a 2.5% fee.
- E-Check: Make a payment with no fees from your checking account. Go to <https://selfservice.cedarville.edu/>

Deferred/4-Month Payment Plan* Due Dates:

August 5, *September 1, *October 1, *November 1
*plus @ 5% annual daily simple interest.

*International students are required to pay in full by August 5, 2024.

Drop/Add Schedule for 16-week courses

No tuition refund is applicable for undergraduate students who remain within the block of 12-17 credits. When applicable, tuition refunds for 16-week courses will be credited according to the following schedule.
